

Casavant Pipe Organ of Knox United Church, Vancouver BC

The organ of Knox United Church was built by Casavant Brothers, Ltd., of St. Hyacinthe Quebec in 1950 as Opus 2037 with 10 stops*. Andrew Chapman of Vancouver installed seven additional Casavant ranks in 1956. The organ was cleaned and enlarged in 1989 by organ builder Adrian Koppejan of Chilliwack. The electro-pneumatic action organ is located on the east side of the chancel behind a screen. The detached two-manual console is on the west side of the chancel.
