## The Details

KnoxVan Events seeking out and inviting artists to submit their work for the "Wayfarer Exhibition – exploring our neighbourhoods" To be a Wayfarer means to taking a journey on foot – something many of us do every day, especially this past little while. This art show is meant to celebrate all the wonders that we have been able to witness by staying closer to home – what is it that you would like to honour on your daily walk? What or who has caught your eye or imagination that you have visited by travelling by foot or wheels? Or perhaps you want to explore the feeling you get on your local hike. However you want to interpret what it means to be a Wayfarer we want to see it!

This call is open to all artists and artisans. Anyone residing in the Lower Mainland is eligible to submit. We are open to all types of artists but please be aware that we are not able to take submissions with violent or overtly nude/sexual subjects as this event will be open to all ages. Please also note that the art submitted must be available in physical form – at this time we are not able to accept solely digital works.

Also, please note that there is no limit to the amount of work submitted but that each artist will be need to stay with in a floor space of approx. 8'X8' Artists will be responsible for ensuring their work has a way of being displayed – please bring a table, easels or plinths for display. Artists in outside locations are recommended to bring or rent a tent. Artists are welcome to bring cards, reproductions, prints or other such items for sale and are encouraged to display a write up about themselves. Please note that any sales that may result from the show will be the responsibility of the artist to arrange and process. KnoxVan Events will not be asking for a portion of any sales.

This exhibition will be taking place at 5600 Balaclava Street (Knox United) where there will be both Indoor and Outdoor placements.

#### Please Note

Artists will be responsible for dropping their work off and setting up their easel/plinth/display between 8:30AM and 9:45AM on Saturday, August 27th. It is recommended that artists stay onsite with their work but are welcome to have a co-worker or stand-in represent their work during the day. Artists also must be available to pick up their work at 4:15PM on Saturday August 27th 2022.

KnoxVan Events is not able offer insurance and you are encouraged to stay with your work.

To submit to be a participating artist please visit knoxvan.com before Sunday, July 31st 2022. *Here artists will be asked to include photos of finished works, a short bio, contact information & social media information.*
