



## *Game Instructions*

The Story Basket is a game inspired by the drama game 'Finish the Story'. Gather a group of people (generally 2-6 people works best) and pick either the oldest or youngest person to start the round - turns move in a clockwise direction.

The person to go first will draw two words, select one to use to start the game and put the other on the table for everyone to see. They will start with a single sentence that utilizes their word, and the person to their left will then add their sentence that continues the story.

The goal is to use the word on the table in a sentence that makes sense to the growing story and each player is only allowed to add a single sentence. Once the word is used, the player who used it adds it to their pile of words collected and draws another word to be used by the group. Continue this pattern until the last word is used and the story has come to a close.

The winner is the person who was able to collect the most words! Keep in mind that the initial word that the first player used for the first sentence at the beginning does not count.
