Sunday January 12

Verse: John 2:1-2

"On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding."

Meditation:

Jesus' presence at the wedding in Cana shows His involvement in our daily lives. Reflect on how He is present in your ordinary moments, ready to bring joy and transformation.

Prayer:

Lord, thank You for being present in my everyday life. Help me to see Your hand in the ordinary and trust in Your provision. Amen.

January 13

Verse: Psalm 40:5

"Many, Lord my God, are the wonders you have done, the things you planned for us; none can compare with you."

Meditation:

Prayer:

January 14

Verse: 1 Corinthians 12:4

Meditation:

January 15

Verse: Isaiah 62:3

"You will be a crown of splendor in the Lord's hand, a royal diadem in the hand of your God."

Meditation:

God values you as a precious and treasured creation. Reflect on your identity in Christ as beloved and cherished.

Prayer:

Lord, thank You for valuing me as Your precious creation. Help me to see myself as You see me and live confidently in Your love. Amen.

January 16

Verse: Psalm 36:7

"How priceless is your unfailing love, O God! People take refuge in the shadow of your wings."

Meditation:

God's love is a safe haven for our hearts. Take a moment today to rest in the assurance of His unfailing love and find peace in His presence.

Prayer:

Lord, Your love is priceless and constant. Thank You for being my refuge and strength. Let me rest in the shadow of Your wings. Amen.

January 17

Verse: John 2:11

"What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him."

Meditation:

Jesus' miracles are signs of His divine power and love. Reflect on how He has revealed His glory in your life and deepened your faith.

Prayer:

Jesus, thank You for showing Your glory in my life. Increase my faith as I see Your power at work in both big and small ways. Amen.

January 18

Verse: Psalm 19:1

"The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands."

Meditation:

Creation itself speaks of God's majesty and creativity. Take time today to observe the world around you and marvel at the beauty He has made.

Prayer:

Lord, Your creation declares Your glory. Help me to see Your hand in everything around me and to praise You for Your wonderful works. Amen.
