November 23, 2025 (Sunday)

**Key Verse:** Mark 13:35

"Therefore, keep awake – for you do not know when the master of the house will come,

in the evening, or at midnight, or at cockcrow, or at dawn,"

Meditation: Jesus calls us to be watchful and ready for His return. Reflect today on what it means to

live in a state of spiritual readiness, anticipating His coming.

and offer your worship to God with reverence and awe.

November 25, 2025 (Tuesday)

**Key Verse:** Psalm 95:1-2

"O come, let us sing to the Lord; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation! Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with

songs of praise!

**Meditation:** Worship is an expression of joy and thanksgiving to God. Take time today to sing or pray

words of gratitude, offering your praise to the Rock of your salvation.

**Prayer:** Lord, I lift my voice to You in praise and thanksgiving. You are my Rock, my salvation,

and I sing for joy in Your presence. Amen.

November 26, 2025 (Wednesday)

Key Verse: Mark 12:44

"For all of them have contributed out of their abundance; but she out of her poverty has

put in everything she had, all she had to live on."

**Meditation:** God values sacrificial giving, no matter the amount. Reflect today on how you can give

more of yourself – your time, resources, or love – in service to God and others.

**Prayer:** Lord, teach me to give generously and sacrificially, just as the widow gave all she had.

Help me to trust You with my resources and use them for Your glory. Amen.

## November 27, 2025 (Thursday)

**Key Verse:** Psalm 80:19

"Restore us, O Lord God of hosts; let your face shine, that we may be saved."

**Meditation:** In times of need, we call on God to restore and shine His face upon us. Reflect today on

where you need God's restoration in your life and ask Him to renew you.

**Prayer:** Lord God, restore me and make Your face shine upon me. Renew my heart and life and

lead me in the path of Your salvation. Amen.

## November 28, 2025 (Friday)

**Key Verse:** Hebrews 10:24

"And let us consider how to provoke one another to love and good deeds,"

**Meditation:** We are called to encourage one another in love and good work. Think today about

someone in your life who needs encouragement and reach out to them with support

and kindness.

**Prayer:** Lord, help me to be an encourager to those around me. Let me spur others on toward

love, kindness, and acts of service, reflecting Your love in my actions. Amen.

## November 29, 2025 (Saturday)

**Key Verse:** Psalm 85:10

"Steadfast love and faithfulness will meet; righteousness and peace will kiss each other."

**Meditation:** God's attributes of love, faithfulness, righteousness, and peace are perfectly united.

Reflect on how you can live out these qualities in your own life, seeking harmony with

others.

**Prayer:** Lord, let Your love, faithfulness, righteousness, and peace be evident in my life. Help me

to live in a way that reflects Your character and brings harmony to those around me.
