The Very Rev. Bruce McLeod passed away on January 13th, 2026 in Orangeville, Ontario at the age of 96.

Very Rev. McLeod was the 25th Moderator (1972-74) who went on to become the Commissioner of the Ontario Human Rights Commission (1975) and was a director of the Canadian Civil Liberties Association. Memorial Service information will follow soon.


