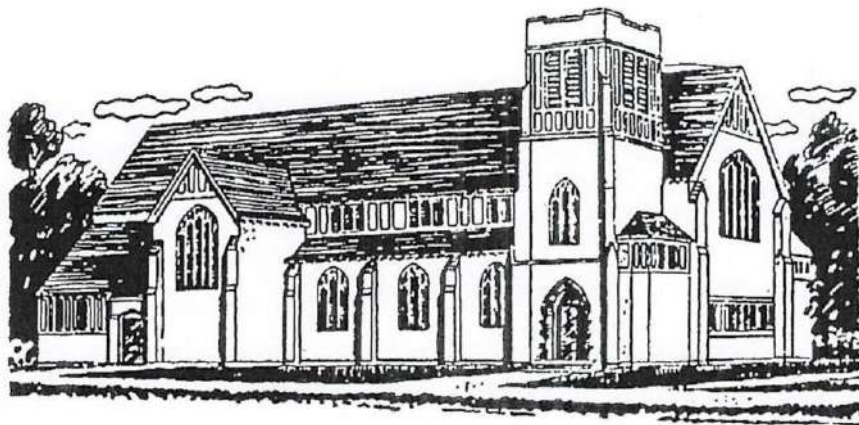

Text: John 20:19-31 *Risen Jesus Appears to the Disciples*
文本：约翰福音 20:19-31 *复活的耶稣向门徒显现*

Synopsis: The risen Jesus comes to the disciples while they are hiding behind locked doors, afraid and uncertain about what comes next. He speaks peace to them, shows them his wounded hands and side, and sends them out in his name. When Thomas, who was absent, struggles to believe, Jesus later meets him with grace rather than condemnation.
