May 24, 2026 (Sunday)

Key Verse: Psalm 121:1–2

“I lift up my eyes to the hills—from where will my help come? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth.”

Meditation: Look up. Your help comes not from circumstances, but from the Creator.

Prayer: Lord, lift my eyes from my worries to your strength. Help me trust your steady hand. Amen.

May 25, 2026 (Monday)

Key Verse: Psalm 16:11

May 26, 2026 (Tuesday)

May 27, 2026 (Wednesday)

Key Verse: Romans 5:5

Meditation: The Holy Spirit fills us with lasting hope. Let that hope carry you today.

Prayer: Holy Spirit, fill me with hope that never fades. Pour your love into my heart again. Amen.

May 28, 2026 (Thursday)

Key Verse: Proverbs 4:23

“Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life.”

Meditation: What we allow into our hearts shapes our lives. Guard your heart with God’s truth and grace.

Prayer: God, help me to guard my heart. Let it overflow with your goodness and life. Amen.

May 29, 2026 (Friday)

Key Verse: Philippians 4:6

“Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.”

Meditation: Prayer replaces anxiety with peace. Talk to God about everything today.

Prayer: Lord, I bring my needs to you with thanksgiving. Let your peace guard my heart. Amen.

Key Verse: Ephesians 2:10

“For we are what he has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works.”

Meditation: You are created with purpose. Step into the good works God has prepared for you.

Prayer: Creator God, thank you for designing me with purpose. Guide me into the good you’ve planned. Amen.
