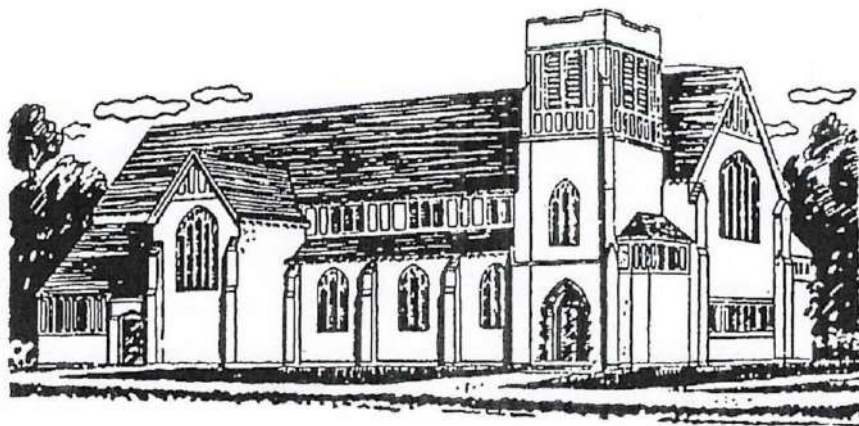

Synopsis: Not all wisdom comes through celebration. Sometimes the most profound insights emerge from difficult seasons—loss, disappointment, and the recognition of our own limits. Ecclesiastes suggests that sorrow, though unwelcome, can deepen our understanding of life and draw us toward humility and compassion.
